## So please get your photos out or get photographing!

As usual, there is just one category - *Views of, in, or around Asby* - and there will as previously be three classes - *Adult, Children 8-16, and Children under 8* 

Entries cost 50p each, and all entries must be submitted by Thursday 15th June.

Entries may be **prints** (as usual - see details below), which must be delivered to **The Hollies** - or **image files**, which should be sent by email to **johnbevan@compuserve.com** 

All entrance fee payments by cash in an envelope, please.

- All prints must be <u>unframed</u>
- Print entries must be no larger than A5 {or about 8"x6"} in size. although the Calendar will be printed in the usual larger size, print entries are restricted in size because of the challenges of handling lots of large prints
- Preference will be given to photographs in landscape orientation
- Print entries must be clearly marked on the reverse with the competitor's name, class (age group), approximate date of photography, a brief title or caption, and accurate details of the location of the photograph: the same information must be provided for all image entries.

## The Small Print

No entry may have been previously published anywhere else. <u>Entries must be clearly identifiable as being views of, in, or</u> <u>around the parish of Asby</u>. It is a condition of entry that the entrant (while retaining the copyright) gives Asby PCC the free right to use the photograph (cropped or enhanced as may be required) in its fund-raising activities (and particularly in the Asby Calendar 2024 if the PCC so chooses), and to publish them (protected against unauthorised downloading) on the Parish website. Entrants <u>must provide a digital file (or an original copy) of each entry on request</u>. Entering one or more photographs implies acceptance of all the conditions of entry.
