What are we learning this half term?


Class 1

Subject	Details
English	Children are learning to write instructions about keeping our environment tidy!
Maths	Children are learning about 2D and 3D shapes, as well as practising addition and subtraction.
Science	Children are learning about materials (like wood, metal, plastic, fabric) and why we use them.
Computing	Children are learning how to give simple instructions to move a robot.
PSHE	Children are learning to talk about their dreams and goals and how to keep trying when something feels tricky
History	Children are learning about famous explorers and why they are remembered.

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What are we learning this half term?

Class 2

Subject	Details
Science	Children are learning about electricity, including understanding which objects need electricity and how to construct a working circuit.
English	Children are writing speeches to raise awareness of plastic pollution.
Maths	Years 3 and 4 are beginning with a unit on times tables, where they will learn to understand, recall and represent times tables facts. Years 5 and 6 will continue with their work on fractions and arithmetic.
Art	The whole school are learning about the polka dot pumpkins of Yayoi Kusama.
Computing	We will learn how to take photos in manual mode and edit them using photo editing software.
History	Key Stage 2 pupils will learn about the Kingdom of Benin, focusing on its powerful obas, magnificent palaces and impressive arts and crafts.
P.E.	The whole school are learning about social, street, classic and modern dancing.
PSHE	Years 3 and 4 will be learning about dreams and goals. The focus will be on building on failure and setting SMART targets.
R.E.	In Spring 1, we will focus on Christianity, with a focus on core beliefs and the life of Jesus.

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
