What are we learning this half term?

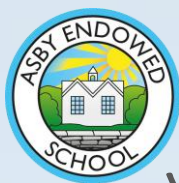
Class 1

Subject	Details
English	We are performing and writing poems about animals, exploring rhyme and verse structures. We will also be writing inspired by <i>Hair Love</i> by Matthew A. Cherry!
Maths	We are learning about fractions, including finding fractions of numbers. We will continue to work on measures of length, capacity and temperature.
Geography	Children will learn about London , exploring its famous landmarks, and how it compares to our local area.
Science	Children will learn about animal and human life cycles , and how living things grow and change over time. We will observe caterpillars and eggs in class as they hatch and develop.
PSHE (Personal, Social, Health, and Economic Education)	Changing Me: Children will learn about how they have grown and changed since they were babies and how they continue to change as they get older.
Computing	Children will learn how to give clear instructions (algorithms) to make a robot or device move. They will use directions, sequencing, and debugging to fix mistakes in their instructions.

What are we learning this half term?

Class 2 and Whole School

Subject	Details
English	We will be writing twisted fairytales, such as Jack and the Baked Beanstalk, which will give pupils an opportunity to further develop their narrative writing and to use direct speech to show character or advance the action.
Science	Lower Key Stage 2 will learn about the properties and types of rocks, including the difference between sedimentary, metamorphic and igneous rocks. We will then turn our attention to fossils and what they show us.
R.E.	Once we have finished our Pilgrimage unit, we will explore the three Abrahamic religions (Christianity, Judaism and Islam) through the lens of religious festivals. Exploring similarities and differences, we will learn about Passover, Lent and Eid.
Art	On the first Monday back, we will spend the afternoon creating our own impressionist landscape painting inspired by Vincent Van Gogh's Starry Night.
DT	We will be making pom poms out of wool, as part of a whole-school project to create a wreath that will be on permanent display.
P.E.	We are fortunate to be joined by external gymnastics coach Lucy Monk for 5 afternoons. Although pupils will have the chance to develop their skills across gymnastics, the particular focus will be on pairs, groups and vaulting.
