



Covid-19 regulations: FAQs

Social distancing? Seats are labelled for 2m spacing, but family groups may of course sit together. Please expect to be directed to a seat. It may also be necessary to direct the order in which people leave the Church at the end of a service.

Hand sanitising? Worshippers will be asked to use hand-sanitiser on entry. You may wish to use the sanitiser on the way out as well.

Masks? Wearing masks is optional unless the guidelines change.

Track and Trace? You will be asked to sign in with a contact number. The list for each service/prayer time will be held for 21 days, then destroyed.

Collection? There will be a plate for your gifts as usual as you come in. The money will be untouched for 72 hours.

Church cleaning? We shall be working to the '72 hours rule': *i.e.* nothing will be cleared away immediately following services and prayer times: instead, this will be done 72 hours later.

Hymns and service books? At present singing is not allowed, but there *will* be music. Hymn and service books will be available and should be left in your pew at the end of worship. Any paper 'extras' should be taken away by worshippers, please, and *not* left for others to clear up.

Toilet & kitchen? We regret that these will be unavailable. Unfortunately, no refreshments will be provided, or friendly chat allowed in the building, after the services.

Children's books & toys? These will also be unavailable.

Private prayer times? There will be a steward on duty, probably in the porch unless the weather is inclement!

Holy Communion? Bread (gluten-free as usual) only. This will be received at the chancel steps to preserve a one-way system.
